

## SERVICE GUIDE

### Presentation

The Al Parco Rehabilitation Center is a health facility accredited with the SSN of the Lazio region (Aut. G.R. Lazio n.1600 / 97, n.52 / 2000, accr. DCA Reg. Lazio n. U00420 / 2013). The Center is located in the territory of the ASL RM3 (Ex RM D), IV District, in A. Armellini 125-127 and has been operating in the Rehabilitation-Private Health sector since 1997.

The Center is accredited for the provision of rehabilitation treatments pursuant to Law 883/78 pursuant to Article 26, in a **semi-residential** and **non-residential** regime, specializing in taking care of people with mental disabilities.

The management company is "Al Parco Società Cooperativa Sociale Onlus", with registered office in Rome. The cooperative has obtained certificate no. IT10 / 0392 certifying the conformity of the Quality system to the ISO 9001: 2008 standard (UNI EN ISO 9001 Ed 2008) and has proceeded to the transition to the ISO 9001: 2015 standard. Both certificates were issued by the SGS Italia company.

The Legal Representative is Dr. **Fabio Micaroni**.

### Services

The Rehabilitation Center includes a **Semi-Residential Rehabilitation Service** (day hospitalization) and a **Non-Residential Rehabilitation Service** (home and / or extramural).

### Organization and staff

1. The **Medical Director** of the Rehabilitation Center is **Dr. Antonella Lo Giudice**, Physician Psychiatrist, responsible for the control of the adequacy and organization of the staff and of the health and hygiene aspects of the Center;
2. Each of the two Services is directed by a doctor, with the function of Responsible Doctor;
3. For each of the two Services there are also one or more Medical Specialists;
4. The figure of the Coordinator is foreseen for each Service

A rehabilitation team operates in each of the two Services which, organized according to the directives of the Lazio Region (doctors, psychologist, social worker, educators, rehabilitation therapists) deals with the formulation of individual rehabilitation projects and taking charge of the users under treatment. .

For the Semi-Residential Service, as required by current legislation, there is also a Nurse.

**Semi-residential service**

Users with mental disabilities, both adults and minors, can access the Service.

The Service is currently organized for adult users, the opportunity for a possible insertion of adolescent users is evaluated by the doctor in charge and by the rehabilitation team.

*The Service is accredited for 30 users.*

Users attend the Center from Monday to Saturday with the following hours: 8.00-14.00 from Monday to Saturday and eat their meals at the Center. With regard to rehabilitation activities, planned on the basis of Individual Rehabilitation Projects, these are carried out within the Center (organized in Laboratories) or, possibly, at affiliated external facilities (rehabilitation activities with an educational, recreational, sporting value).

All rehabilitation activities are carried out by specialized personnel (rehabilitation therapists, psychomotor therapists, professional educators, psychologists, psychotherapists, doctors) and are aimed at improving users' basic skills, socialization, autonomy. The workers active within the Center may undergo variations in their organization, in relation to the specific technical and organizational needs and the specific aptitudes of users. The following laboratories are currently active:

**Restoration - Psychomotor skills - Expressive-musical - Body expression and relaxation - Color - Shadow theater - Construction of objects - Information technology**

Group psychological support interventions and individual psychotherapy interventions are also provided. Each user participates in those activities deemed most useful and effective from the rehabilitation point of view for his specific situation.

**Non-residential service**

Users with mental disabilities, both adults and minors, access the Service.

*The Service is accredited for 20 users.*

Non-residential treatments are generally carried out outside the premises of the Center, at the user's home or at external territorial structures (schools, sports centers, libraries, etc.). The times of the interventions are agreed with the individual user, based on the availability of the same and the organizational needs of the Service. Generally, the direct intervention with the user is carried out by one or more reference professional educators and is specifically aimed at improving autonomy.

### Where to find us

The Rehabilitation Center is located in Rome, in Via A. Armellini, 125-127 CAP 00149, in the territory of Municipality 11.

### How to reach us

The Center can be easily reached by car via the Via della Magliana, Via Ostiense and Lungotevere S. Paolo.

The public transports that pass in the immediate vicinity are:

- bus 128, 775, 781;

- Villa Bonelli train stop connected with Rome Tiburtina, Rome Tuscolana, Rome Ostiense, Rome Trastevere. Buses are connected to the neighboring metro stops: Marconi, Eur Palasport, Eur Magliana.
